ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

 Chancellor's Scholarship (six awarded each yr.)

This scholarship pays \$810 each fall and spring, and full tuition for summer session for two consecutive years. Requirements are: 25 ACT composite; first time, full-time student; 3.0 cum. GPA and full-time status per semester required to maintain scholarship.

 Academic Excellence

This scholarship pays full tuition each fall, spring and summer session for two consecutive years. Requirements are: 23 ACT composite; first time, full-time student. A minimum 2.75 cum. GPA and full-time status per semester are required to maintain scholarship.

 Technical Achievement

This scholarship pays full tuition each fall, spring and summer session for two consecutive years. Requirements are: 23 ACT composite or 3.0 GPA in high school technical curriculum; first time, full-time student; student must enroll in a technical program. A minimum 2.75 cum GPA and full-time status per semester are required to maintain scholarship.
