



The method(s) used by the institution to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act was determined by allocating awards based on eligibility criteria outlined in the CARES Act and awarded on a tiered point system based on the total student semester credit hours (SSCH) the student was enrolled. The table below outlines how the grants were awarded and disbursed. Awards per student for the summer semesters are lower based on length of program and other factors. Beginning Spring 2021, PELL eligible students were granted priority in awarding grants through the CRRSAA and ARPA. Awards continued to be awarded based on a tiered system based on total SSCH enrolled.
