In the semester a student applies for graduation, he or she also registers for BSAD 4010, Career Catalyst Completion to have their activities certified.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>8</sup> The PCCUA in Business Administration degree does not include Business Calculus, which is required for UA Little Rock College of Business majors and is a prerequisite to several business core classes. Additionally, both Microeconomics and Macroeconomics should be completed prior to moving to Upper Level courses. Lastly, BAN 263, Business Communications will not transfer for credit as BINS 3380, but simply as an elective. If these classes are completed at PCCUA, then the necessary work at UA Little Rock includes only the Upper Level courses noted on this sheet.
