All students take BSAD 2010, Introduction to Career Catalyst upon declaring a major in the College. Over the period of their College of Business coursework, students must complete at least one activity in each of five career development areas. In the semester a student applies for graduation, he or she also registers for BSAD 4010, Career Catalyst Completion to have their activities certified.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>7</sup> The UA Little Rock business core requires students to demonstrate proficiency with use of information technology through testing.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>8</sup> The PCCUA in Business Administration degree does not include Business Calculus, which is required for UA Little Rock College of Business majors and is a prerequisite to several business core classes. Additionally, both Microeconomics and Macroeconomics should be completed prior to moving to Upper Level courses. Lastly, BAN 263, Business Communications will not transfer for credit as BINS 3380, but simply as an elective. If these classes are completed at PCCUA, then the necessary work at UA Little Rock includes only the Upper Level courses noted on this sheet.
