

Bachelor of Business Administration - Online Completion Degree Option

Phillips Community College of the University of Arkansas (PCCUA) students interested in earning a Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) degree from the University of Arkansas – Fort Smith (UAFS) may complete the first two years (lower division coursework) of the bachelor degree requirements at PCCUA by completing an Associate of Arts in Business Administration from PCCUA. Completed PCCUA courses will be accepted by UAFS and applied to the BBA requirements according to the UAFS Undergraduate Academic Catalog. UAFS will offer the remaining requirements through the BBA - Online Completion Degree Option. UAFS course requirements completed at PCCUA will count toward the UAFS residency requirements for conferral of the degree.

1. General Education Core Requirements, see Graduation Requirements section of the UAFS Undergraduate Academic Catalog or NPS AS Business General Education Core requirements. Follow requirements with these stipulations: mathematics – MS 223 Survey of Calculus and BMGT 283 Business Statistics are required.			
2. These courses are used to determine major courses in residency, see UAFS Graduation Requirements. A cumulative GPA of 2.25 is required in these courses to meet graduation requirements for the College of Business.			

3. Electives, 10 hours. Select courses with advisor. PCCUA courses of MATH 1123 College Algebra and BUS 1193 Consumer Economics will count for elective hours plus 4 additional hours.
4. Must have completed an associate's degree with a grade of "C" or higher in all lower-level business core courses for admission to the BBS Online Completion Degree Option.
5. Major Electives, 24 hours. Must be upper-level courses within the College of Business and at least three business disciplines must be represented (ACCT, COBI, ECON, FIN, LAW, MGMT, or MKTG. Consult with business advisor.
6. Required Business Computing Competency may be fulfilled by successful completion of CIS 1013 Information Systems from NPS.
7. Prior to graduation students must demonstrate competency in financial literacy by satisfactory completion of FIN 1521 Personal Finance Applications (or an approved substitution) with a grade of C or better, or by a score of 70% or more on a challenge exam for FIN 1521.
