Arkansas Transfer Achievement Scholarship

The University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, (UAF), has a scholarship that reduces tuition rates for students, who graduate with an associate's degree from PCCUA and then transfer to the Fayetteville campus.

Earn an associate's degree from PCCUA, then transfer to UAF to work towards a bachelor's degree and pay the same basic credit hour tuition paid at PCCUA.

To be eligible to receive an Arkansas Transfer Achievement Scholarship, a graduate must:

- Be an Arkansas resident
- Earn an associate's degree (AA, AS or AA in teaching) from PCCUA
- Complete degree at PCCUA the semester prior to enrolling in UAF on-campus program
- Have a cumulative 2.0 grade point average, renewable for up to 10 semesters
- · Meet all other U of A admission criteria and program requirements
- Enroll in an on-campus undergraduate degree program, full or part-time

This scholarship applies to the base tuition at UAF, and recipients will still be required to pay all applicable fees, as well as any differential tuition above the base rate charged by programs.
