- Courses with a NG prefix must be taken in sequence prescribed.
- Nursing courses older than 3 years will not count toward meeting curricular requirements for graduation from the Associate Degree Nursing program.
- In Fall 2025, the program initiated a pilot of a zero-credit, one-hour mandatory Nursing Success course for Levels I, II, and III. If the pilot proves successful, the course will be officially included in the 2026–2027 handbook.
