- Lily Peter Auditorium - \$800
- FA Community Room - \$700
- 1/2 of Fine Arts Community Room - \$400
- FA 150 - \$400
- FA Community Room & FA 150 - \$900
- FA Lobby - \$300
- Hendrix Gallery - \$380
- Fine Arts Center Full Cooking Kitchen - \$250
(Must use a licensed caterer)

Venues may be reserved for decorating the day before the event for one-half of the full-day contract rate, if less than four hours is needed. If more than four hours is needed, the venue may be rented for a full-day contract rate.

General Policies and Discounts

- 50% deposit required at time of booking.
- Security services are not included with rental.
- Sound and lighting services are not included with rental fee.
- Balance due within 14 days of event.
- Deposit refundable upon cancellation 14 days prior to the event.
- 25% discount off commercial rates for individuals and not-for-profit organizations for non-commercial purposes.
- 50% discount for PCCUA employees for non-commercial purposes.
- 50% discount for schools or other educational entities (does not apply to graduations, proms).
- Prices are based on full-day rental. 50% discount available for half-day rentals.
- Full-day rental availability - 8:00 a.m. to 12 a.m.
- Half-day rental available Monday-Friday
 - 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. or
 - 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.

The Hendrix Fines Arts Center was originally built in 1972. The Center provides much needed space for community events. The Lily Peter Auditorium is named in honor of local philanthropist, Lily Peter, who contributed significantly to the construction of the facility. The Center is well known for hosting the Warfield Concert Series as well as other cultural events.

In 2019, the Fine Arts Center was renovated with a generous donation from Bettye and Dick Hendrix and renamed the Hendrix Fine Arts Center.



The lobby of the Hendrix Fine Arts Center offers a welcoming space for any special event. The space is also available for smaller meetings.



The auditorium seats up to 1,138 guests and offers a full-service stage/backstage, as well as classrooms for rehearsals and costume changes, and restrooms.



The Community Room can accommodate up to 400 guests and can be divided into multiple rooms as needed.

The Hendrix Gallery offers a smaller meeting room and can accommodate up to 30.



A full-service kitchen is available for an additional fee for special events.
