Priority Initiative in 2017-2018 Strategic Plan	Status
Improve the ADN program completion rate in 100% time	29.7% (11/37) of the cohort admitted in Fall 15 completed the program in 100% time compared to a 21% (8/38) program completion rate in 100% time for of the cohort admitted in Fall 16. This reflects a decrease of (1.4%) in the 100% program completion rate. However, the 150% completion rate increased from 20% for the cohort admitted in Fall 14 to 45.9% for the cohort admitted in Fall 15.
Improve the PN program completion rate in 100% time	36.1% (13/36) of the cohort admitted in Spring 15 completed the program in 100% time compared to a 37.5% (12/32) program completion rate in 100% time for the cohort admitted in Fall 16. This reflects a small (1.4%) increase in the program completion rate.
Improve the MLT program completion rate in 100% time	35.7% (5/14) of the cohort admitted in Fall 15 completed the program in 100% time compared to a 41.7% (5/12) program completion rate in 100% time for the cohort admitted in Fall 16. This reflects a 6% increase in the 100% program completion rate.
Improve the PLB program completion rate in 100% time.	86% (6/7) of the cohort admitted in Fall 16 completed the program in 100% time compared to a 75% (3/4) program completion rate in 100% time for the cohort admitted in Fall 17. This reflects an 11% increase in the 100% program completion rate for fall admission cohorts. 86% (6/7) of the cohort admitted in Spring 17 completed the program in 100% time compared to a 75% (6/8) program completion rate in 100% time for the cohort admitted in Spring 18. This reflects an 11% decrease in the 100% program completion rate for spring admission cohorts.
