Priority Initiative in 2018-2019 Strategic Plan	Status
Improve the ADN program completion rate in 100% time.	38.5% (15/39) of the cohort admitted in Fall 17 completed the program in 100% time compared to a 21% (8/38) program completion rate in 100% time for of the cohort admitted in Fall 16. This reflects an increase of (17.5%) in the 100% program completion rate.
Improve the PN program completion rate in 100% time.	36.1% (13/36) of the cohort admitted in Spring 15 completed the program in 100% time compared to a 37.5% (12/32) program completion rate in 100% time for the cohort admitted in Fall 16. Since a cohort is admitted every third semester on a (F, SP, F or SP, F, SP) rotation, a new cohort was not admitted in 2018. Based on the rotation schedule, the next cohort was admitted in the fall of 2019. As such, the faculty are continuing to implement strategies to increase the completion rate in 100% time.
Improve the MLT program completion rate in 100% time.	50% (5/10) of the cohort admitted in Fall 17 completed the program in 100% time compared to a 41.7% (5/12) program completion rate in 100% time for the cohort admitted in Fall 16. This reflects an increase of (8.3%) in the 100% program completion rate.
Improve the annual PLB graduate performance on Boards.	85.7% (6/7) of Fall 18 PLB graduates passed the BOC on the first attempt compared to 25% (1/4) Fall 17 graduates who passed the BOC on the first attempt.
