<b>Priority Initiative in 2015-2016 Strategic Plan</b>	<b>Status</b>
ADN Faculty will submit to ACEN SSR and SPE for reaffirmation of accreditation	ACEN peer evaluators conducted a site visit September 24-26. The team found the program compliance with all standards and recommended continued approval for 8 years. Their recommendation will be considered by the ERP in January of 2018 and BOC in March of 2018.
ADN Faculty will submit the ASBN SSR for continued program approval.	A detailed SSR was submitted to ASBN in March of 2017. In May of 2017, the ASBN Education Committee approved full continuing program approval through 2022.
PN faculty will implement and evaluate new contemporary nursing curriculum.	The PN faculty currently are implementing the third semester of the new contemporary curriculum. The first cohort will complete the new curriculum in December 2017. PN faculty will monitor this cohort's performance on the licensure exam.
MLT faculty will increase graduate performance on Boards.	5 of 6 (83%) graduates passed the BOC on the first attempt. The previous year 3 of 3 (100%) passed on the first attempt. The program is currently meeting the NAACLS 3-year mean benchmark of at least 70%.
PLB faculty will increase the job placement rate for program graduates.	66% of PLB graduates were employed as a phlebotomist compared to 63% of PLB graduates employed as a phlebotomist the previous year.
PLB faculty will increase the number of graduates who take Boards.	7 of 15 (47%) of PLB graduates took the BOC compared to 5 of 16 (31%) the previous year.

ADN faculty is revising program admission requirements to increase the program completion rate.

PN faculty have implemented ATI remediation and assessment modules and will host an ATI live review in the fall of 2017 to maintain licensure pass rates.

MLT faculty will continue to increase learning activities and resources for students to improve Board pass rates.

PLB faculty will continue to modify clinical rotation schedules to increase employment in field and encourage graduates to take the Board.
