DeWitt Campus was formerly Rice Belt Technical Institute. In June of 1996 the State of Arkansas transferred the former RBTI to Phillips College and on July 1, 1996 Phillips County Community College became part of the University of Arkansas System and RBTC became PCCUA DeWitt Campus.

Programs

All student on the DeWitt campus are able to acquire an Associate of Arts degree or an Associate of Applied Science. PCCUA offers many of the courses needed to complete that degree through the University of Arkansas On-line Consortium. We have four programs which students cannot acquire in DeWitt: Associate Degree in Nursing, Medical Lab Technology, Phlebotomy, and Cosmetology.
