**Date of Inception**

In March of 1996 Arkansas County passed a referendum to annex the County into the PCCC taxing district. The PCCUA Board of Trustees changed the name of the College to Phillips Community College to reflect the multi-county support and began plans to expand the off campus support in Stuttgart. July 1, 1996 Phillips Community College with its expanded Stuttgart campus became part of the University of Arkansas System.

**Programs** All student on the Stuttgart campus are able to acquire an Associate of Arts degree or an Associate of Applied Science. PCCUA offers many of the courses needed to complete that degree through the University of Arkansas On-line Consortium. We have three programs which students cannot acquire in Stuttgart: Medical Lab Technology, Phlebotomy, and Cosmetology.
